50 year old male with neck pain Hit on the head with garage door a few weeks prior

Physical Examination • BP: 70/41

- Pulse: 118
- No standard orthopedic tested noted in the records (foraminal compression, soto hall, spurlings, jacksons)
- "Orthopedic test function to reproduce symptoms as this helps to correlate mechanism of pain"
- "Cervical flexion was restricted and elicited a pain reaction"
- \bullet Check next to C5 diagram as to subluxation on the left






Patient was adjusted prone on the same day as the x ray

- Patient was treated 9 times in a 24-day period
- Minimal improvement with treatment
 - Patient said he thought the treatment was making him worse
 The doctor never changed the type of treatment provided
- Chiropractor did tell the patient to go to the emergency room but the patient did not comply – no insurance
 - The doctor continued to treat the patient.
- After the fourth visit the patient reported that he was having so much pain that he had to hold his head up after the treatment

- After the final visit, the patient reported feelings of suicide due to his intense pain
- 2.5 hours after the final visit, the treating chiropractor sent a fax to a local pain doctor about the patient's intense pain and feeling of suicide
 - He never called the office to confirm receipt or to discuss the patient's case
- Approximately 5 days after the final visit the patient presented to the ER

- Spinal Infection
 Endplate is infected first then moves to the disc
 - Endplate destruction in this case with initial prevertebral swelling
 X ray can be negative for 2-4 weeks
- · Bimodal age
 - Pediatric
 - Over 50yo
- Remote other infection in about 25%
- Present with

 - Back pain in over 90%
 LESS COMMON fever UNDER 20%
- Staphylococcus Aureus most common 60%
- Single level- 65%

HADD in Achilles tendon


- Likely related to prior trauma

Morton's Neuroma


- >3mm is abnormal
- Mulder Sign
 Palpable click resulting from displacement of the intermetatarsal mass on lateral compression
- Displacement is visible on US
