



The Anatomy of a Subsequent Routine Office Visit (ROV) Episodic Care (OV#2)

This sample is an example of the first Routine Office Visit (ROV) of an episode of care. The prior visit was the initial visit, and even though treatment may have been rendered on that first visit, this is the first in the ROV format. Often, with Electronic Health Records (EHR) software, this visit is expressed in a different template than the initial. Layout in this format allows for a continuation of visits in this style throughout the episode of care.

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Daily Encounter: treatment for acute/active care on **visit #2** of a projected 20 visits.

- **Chief Complaint:** Reports deep, aching, stiffness type discomfort in the center of the back of the **neck**; this complaint has stayed the same since the initial visit.
- **Pain Scale:** 6/10 reported using Verbal or Visual Analog Scale
 - **ADL Change:** **sleeping has not improved yet**

● Visit number is clearly indicated

● Location and spinal region is clear

● Patient specific functional notes included

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Daily Objective Findings:

- Vertebral Subluxation(s): Palpation and examination revealed subluxation(s) at the following spinal levels **C3, C4, C5, right L4, right L5, and right sacrum**; edema, fixation, hypomobility and spinal process deviation (misalignment) was noted at all levels.

● Spinal restrictions match segments adjusted

● Soft tissue findings match areas treated

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Assessment:

Patient's responses are WNL of initiating treatment to a problem area. Expectations are improvements in condition and function through the course of this plan rather than each visit. Continue with the treatment as ordered.

● Daily assessment is personalized and patient specific

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Today's Treatment:

Primary Treatment:

- **Diversified/Gonstead** - Chiropractic Manipulative Treatment (CMT) to the **C3, C4, C5, right L4, right L5, and right sacrum** spinal level(s).

● Chiropractic technique clearly indicated

● Specific segments adjusted are noted

Supportive Therapy:

- **As per treatment plan - Hot Pack:** hot moist pack applied to **posterior cervical (neck) and lumbar region(s)** for **15 minutes**.
- **As per treatment plan - Ultrasound with contact medium** applied to **posterior cervical (neck) region(s)** for **8 minutes** at a setting of continuous 100% and at 1.0 W/cm².
- **As per treatment plan - EMS attended** low volt EMS applied to **lumbar, left sacroiliac and right sacroiliac region(s)** for **15 minutes**.

● Specific attended or unattended modalities with body areas treated are documented

● Individual and total therapy time documented

Total time spent for timed therapies: 23 minutes

Advised

- **Tx Effect:** Treatment rendered without incident
- **Next Visit:** continue with treatment plan as scheduled
